## **FLUSHING OF THE WATER DISTRIBUTION MAINS**

**PURCELLVILLE, Va. October 14, 2015** — During the week of October 19, 2015 and continuing for several weeks, the Town of Purcellville will be conducting water system maintenance that involves the flushing of the water distribution mains throughout the town. Some water customers may experience sporadic cases of dirty water and/or low pressure issues for a short time due to the opening and closing of valves during this activity. Part of this maintenance is to ensure that the town is providing adequate water pressures and flows for fire protection. The Town appreciates the patience and understanding of residents and visitors during this maintenance period.

### **The Town of Purcellville, Virginia**

Purcellville is an award-winning town of nearly 8,300 residents located in Loudoun County, approximately 40 miles west of Washington, DC. It has been honored for its green initiatives, most recently with the prestigious Siemens Sustainability Award for Small Communities. The Town has an elected Mayor and six Town Council members. Once a stop along the W&OD rail line, Purcellville has maintained its historic old-town feel through the restoration and maintenance of its many downtown structures, reflecting the Victorian architecture popular during the early 1900s. Today, Purcellville is the economic hub of western Loudoun County and a popular weekend destination for antiques, entertainment, farmer's markets, wineries, breweries, distilleries and restaurants.
