SIDEWALK REPAIRS AND RAMP INSTALLATION

PURCELLVILLE, Va. October 29, 2015 — Beginning Friday, October 30, 2015 and continuing through Friday, November 6, 2015 between the hours of 9AM and 3PM, the Town's contractor, Dominion Concrete, will be making sidewalk repairs as well as installing an ADA compliant ramp along Maple Avenue from Loudoun Valley High School to W.T. Druhan Boulevard. Please use caution in the area during this time.
