POLICE REPORT

PURCELLVILLE, Va. February 18th, 2016 —

02/12/2016 - 11:34p.m. 100 Blk. N. 16th St. **Trespassing**

A resident reported that he invited an acquaintance over then he refused to leave after they got into an argument. On police arrival, the person had left and the resident was advised what procedures to follow to not allow him to return in the future.

02/13/2016 – 10:50p.m. 200 Blk. N. Maple Ave. **DWI and Drunk in Public**

A Police Officer stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation. It was determined that the driver (Delvin Moten, a 52 year old male of Purcellville) was intoxicated and was arrested for DWI. Two passengers (Carmen Trudell, a 39 year old female of Purcellville, Rachelle Russell , a 26 year old female of Leesburg) were intoxicated and refused attempts to have rides pick them up. They were arrested for drunk in public. All arrestees were transported to the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center and held until sober.
