COMING TO FIREMAN'S FIELD PARKING LOT
TUESDAY, MARCH 22**

PURCELLVILLE, Va. February 23, 2016 — The Town of Purcellville is pleased to announce that the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) mobile customer service center, *DMV 2 Go*, will be available to provide full service on **Tuesday, March 22, 2016 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the parking lot of Fireman's Field/Bush Tabernacle at 250 South Nursery Avenue.**

The full service office provides all DMV transactions including applying for and renewing driver's licenses, ID cards, Virginia's Vital Records, and Virginia's veterans ID card. Road and knowledge tests are available, and applicants may get their pictures taken.

You are encouraged to research and bring the required documents to complete your transactions. To determine what documents are needed, use the interactive document guide at www.dmvNOW.com.

- ▶ Obtain vehicle titles, license plates, decals, transcripts.
- ▶ Order disabled parking placards or plates.
- ▶ Purchase hunting and fishing licenses and temporary boat registrations.
- ▶ Apply for Virginia birth certificates.
- ▶ Recently moved? Stop in to update your address on your DMV record. At the same time you can update your voter registration address and organ donor status.
- ▶ Request a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to set up a myDMV account – receive DMV notices via email or phone; conduct secure transactions on the DMV website, www.dmvNOW.com.
- ▶ Search for other state services through a Virginia Internet portal.
