**DMV MOBILE CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTER
COMING TO FIREMAN'S FIELD PARKING LOT
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 22 & FUTURE DATES**

PURCELLVILLE, Va. June 21, 2016 — As a reminder, the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) mobile customer service center, *DMV 2 Go*, will be available to provide full service tomorrow, **Wednesday, June 22, 2016 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the parking lot of Fireman's Field/Bush Tabernacle at 250 S. Nursery Ave.**

In addition, the DMV will return to Purcellville on the following dates from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the same location:

- August 24th
- September 21st
- December 21st

The full service office provides all DMV transactions including applying for and renewing driver's licenses, ID cards, Virginia's Vital Records, and Virginia's veterans ID card. Road and knowledge tests are available, and applicants may get their pictures taken.
