The Town of Purcellville is updating our Comprehensive Plan, and we are getting ready for perhaps the most exciting round of public input yet. Starting May 19<sup>th</sup>, you are invited to envision Purcellville's future with the Planning Commission. The community has already shared what it loves about the Town and what kind of land uses it prefers, so now is your opportunity to work with your neighbors to use that information to help design what Purcellville could look like in 20 years.

On Thursday, May 19<sup>th</sup> the Town will be holding a public Visioning Workshop from 7:00-9:00 PM at Purcellville Town Hall (221 South Nursery Avenue, Purcellville, Virginia) to engage you in creating a vision for areas in and near town. At this workshop, you will work directly with other members of your community in a small facilitated group to create a mapped plan for what the Purcellville area should look like in the future. On Saturday, May 21<sup>st</sup> the Town will host a tent during the Purcellville Music and Arts Festival at Fireman's Field (250 South Nursery Avenue, Purcellville, Virginia) where the public can review the maps created at the Workshop and consolidated scenarios based on these maps. These scenarios will then be ranked by each member of the community. In case you are unable to attend either of these events, you will also be able to view and rank the results of the Visioning Workshop at [www.PlanPurcellville.com](http://www.PlanPurcellville.com) starting May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The scores for each scenario received online or at the Music and Arts Festival will be used to determine which scenarios undergo an impact analysis prior to the next round of workshops tentatively scheduled for July 9<sup>th</sup>.
